

# Crispy Wave Fern Care

*Japanese Asplenium nidus crispum*



Feed once a month

## Light

- Crispy Wave Fern's prefer low light. If you've made it a home in a South or West-facing window, provide shade when the sun is shining directly. Low to medium indirect light is best.
- In the summer, you can move your Crispy Wave Fern onto a patio, but keep it in a shaded area. To preserve that nice even shape, rotate the pot occasionally for even light distribution.

## Food

- Feed once a month with a liquid all purpose fertilizer (20-20-20) diluted to half strength, except during the winter months (Nov-Dec-Jan-Feb).
- Only use liquid fertilizer; avoid pellets which can cause chemical burns.

## Water

- You can water from the top, but make sure there is good drainage at the bottom of the pot. The soil should be kept lightly moist, never allow it to dry out or sit in standing water. One to two drinks a week is the standard.
- As it grows, you'll need to re-pot it into a larger pot, where it will require more water. You may spray the leaves in the summer to increase the ambient humidity. Reduce the frequency of watering in the winter months (Nov-Dec-Jan-Feb) during the dormant period.

## Temperature

- Your Crispy Wave Fern thrives in temperatures between 70 and 80 Fahrenheit (20-25°C). Make sure to avoid large fluctuations in temperature, do not keep your plant below 55°F (13°C) and avoid exposure to very hot temperatures above 100°F (35°C)

## About

- Your Crispy Wave Fern is a beautifully sculpted Japanese fern that functions as a natural air purifier in your home. Not all plants have the same ability to clean the air, and Crispy Wave's have a higher CO<sub>2</sub> to O<sub>2</sub> conversion, releasing more oxygen than any other houseplant. It is by far the most efficient air filtering plant for your home, office or classroom
